Skyward

How is your child doing in school? Now, with a few clicks of the mouse, you can quickly check their progress.

Just log in to Comal ISD's <u>Skyward</u> <u>portal</u> to see grades, class schedules, attendance and set up parent notifications. You also can change an address or phone number, add emergency contacts, or update health information for your child.

Download the Skyward Mobile Access App (from the App Store or Google Play – search for "Skyward Mobile App) to a smartphone or tablet and get the same information even faster with the tap of a finger. Follow these <u>instructions</u> to set up the app.

Campus Student Arrival and Dismissal Procedures:

MORNING ARRIVAL: Student morning arrival is on the west side of the building by the gym doors from 7:00am to 7:30am. Due to traffic flow and safety concerns, please do not drop your child off at the front of the campus. If you are dropping your child off after 7:30am, please park in the upper parking lot (not in the red emergency lanes) and walk with your child into the building. Your child is tardy if they are not in their classroom by 7:35. Students will meet in the gym in the morning, and will be directed to the cafeteria if they are eating breakfast at school.

AFTERNOON DISMISSAL via PARENT PICKUP: We will provide pickup hangtags for families who do not have one from last year. One will need to be displayed in your window as you pick-up your child. If you do not have a hang tag please report to the front office with your driver's license to receive your child.

Student Early Check-Out

Only authorized adults, as indicated on the child's Skyward account, are permitted to check students out early during the day. A current driver's license must be provided to the office to verify identity.

If you are contacted by Nurse Manley and are asked to come pick up your child, please make your way to campus as soon as possible.

School Age Child Care

School-aged children are welcome to register for after school childcare through SACC. They operate each day school is in session and run a full-day program during the summer at seven rotating sites. They provide the highest quality childcare that meets the needs of each child and family in a safe, nurturing and enriching environment.

Our program begins immediately after school (even on early release days) and closes at 6:30 p.m. on regular school days. The program is closed on all student holidays. Enrollment is limited, so it is best to register as soon as possible.

Birthday treats are enjoyed the last few minutes of the instructional day. Please communicate at least 24 hours before to your child's teacher and the front office that you will be dropping off birthday treats for your child. These should be dropped off in morning before 10am.

Birthday treats must be <u>STORE BOUGHT</u>, <u>AND NUT FREE</u>. Please send a treat to eat, and not balloons, toys, etc. that will cause a distraction during the instructional day.

Party invitations that are passed out at school must include the entire class or all the same gender as your child. This greatly alleviates hurt feelings that may distract from our school day.

Safety Procedures for RCES Visitors

Keeping our students safe at school is a top priority. Always check-in through the front office. Our school visitor check-in system requires a scan of your current driver's license. Please always have your driver's license identification with you when visiting our campus. Once your license is scanned, we will print a VISITOR'S BADGE for you. Always display your visitor's badge on your upper left shoulder so it is easily visible by all staff members.

Visiting Your Child for Lunch

Parents and Guardians may enjoy lunch with their child during your child's regularly scheduled lunchtime. Our Café has designated "Parent Tables" where you will sit with your child. Visitors are not permitted to sit at the classroom tables with the other students. Parents may have lunch with their child only. Other students are not permitted to join visitors at the Parents Table.

After lunch, parents/guardians are to exit the campus via the front office. Parents are not permitted to go with the child into their classroom or to recess.

Volunteering on Campus

All campus volunteers must complete the online volunteer background check prior to volunteering on campus. This includes mentors, tutors, field trip chaperones, workroom volunteers, etc...
